**25th Anniversary of the
Northville Public Library**

On June 10, 1986, the voters of the Northville Central School District passed a proposition (294 yes / 113 no) for a \$17,000 budget, and thus created the Northville Public Library.

Earlier that year, the Board of the Northville Book Station held a public meeting with State library officials to discuss the options for a library. The "hand to mouth" existence of the past five years could not go on any longer.

Volunteers and library supporters took to the streets contacting organizations, churches, and households. They explained what a school district library was and its benefits.

Twenty five years later the Northville Public Library thrives at its original location at 341 South Third Street, still providing services with cheer and openness.

However, some things have changed in these years. The rear addition was opened in 1999, and the second floor meeting space was added in 2009. Public access computers and Wifi connection, an online catalog and website, audio and visual materials have all come into existence.

The paved parking lot, handicap ramp, gardens and gazebo overlooking the lake, and the Sacandaga Local History Room are all new.

Celebrate with us in this milestone year. Stop into the library, become a Friend, look out on the lake, see some art, discuss a book, receive a smile. It's your community gathering place from toddlers through teens, from new parents to senior citizens.
