

From the romantic, medieval villages and mesmerizing landscapes of Portugal's Alentejo region to Andalusia's vibrant cities and historic palaces, there is much to see here. Traveling by bicycle from Lisbon on the Portuguese Atlantic coast to Granada in Southern Spain, one gets to appreciate the beautiful landscapes, the strategic – as in steep climb - locations of medieval castle villages in the Sierra Morena mountains, the endless fields of sun flowers and cork trees in the Extremadura region of Spain and the leisurely atmosphere of rural villages. The architectural wonders built by the Moors such as the Alhambra in Granada and the Mezquita in Cordoba are true world wonders. Enjoy the scenery from the comfort of your chair (instead of a hard bicycle seat).
