A few of our veterans (American Legion) on Memorial Day about 11 years ago.





## Highway reports:


1935 Resolution to abandon road near Pal-  
mateer's

1945 Supervisor Frank Langr reported: The  
public demand for better roads, passable at all  
hours of the day and night, poses an added  
responsibility upon the Town today. The cost  
of giving the public these services cost the tax-  
payers almost twenty thousand dollars yearly  
compared to about five thousand dollars spent  
for the same purpose twenty years ago.

1945 Notice hereby given: That pursuant to  
section 142 Highway Law of 1945 and by  
recommendation of the Superintendent of  
Highway to purchase highway equipment at  
a cost not in excess of \$500.00.

1948 Maple Grove Road will officially be  
known as County Road 143

1951 Highway Superintendent Palmateer rec-  
ommended the purchase of truck and snow  
plowing equipment cost at least \$500.00, but  
not to exceed \$3500.
